

Resolution For Homer Township Protecting Second Amendment

Resolution opposing the passage of any bill to restrict the individual right of United States Citizens as protected by the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution

WHEREAS, the right of the people to keep and bear arms is guaranteed as an individual right under the Second Amendment to the United States Constitution and under the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and;

WHEREAS, the right of the people to keep and bear arms for defense of life, liberty, and property is regarded as an inalienable right by the people of Homer Township, Illinois, and;

WHEREAS, the people of Illinois derive benefit from all safe forms of firearms for recreation, hunting, and shooting using all types of firearms allowable under the United States Constitution, and;

WHEREAS, numerous bills continue to be introduced in the Legislature to infringe on the right to keep and bear arms and ban the possession and use of certain firearms, for defense of life, liberty, and property and would ban the possession and use of firearms now employed in safe forms of recreation, hunting, and shooting, and;

WHEREAS, the Homer Township Board intends to support the Second Amendment rights of the law abiding citizens of Homer Township Illinois, and is voicing its opposition to any unconstitutional infringement of those rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT BE AND IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the elected Homer Township Board does hereby oppose the enactment of any legislation that would unconstitutionally infringe upon the right of the people to keep and bear arms, and urges our elected officials to support said rights.
